

11.08.2022 INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION


AZADI KA AMRIT MAHOTSAV



16.08.22 PARENT - TEACHER MEETING : 2021 ADMISSION


Parents meeting of S2 B. Com students (2021 admission) was held on 16.08.22 at 10:00 am in the Commerce seminar hall.






19.10.2022 HANDS ON WORKSHOP FOR BROCHURE MAKING






07.12.2022 HANDS ON TRAINING ON FABRIC PAINTING

- Madhubani





21.12.2022 GROUP DISCUSSION ON “WHY DRUGS”


12.01.2023 GROUP DISCUSSION

B.com) give training to students on Bottle art, Carpet making, Frame designing etc . 30 students participated in the training programme.




04.03.2023 ALUMNI MEET





The Department of Commerce organized parents meeting S3 students' of 2021 admission on 14.03.2023 at 09:30 am in the commerce seminar hall.


Agenda: S1 Result Discussion.





28.04.2023 VALEDICTORY FUNCTION OF COMMERCE ASSOCIATION


