Aim


- The aim of the present project is to begin a butterfly garden with in the College campus with the support of NCC of our College.

























2. Flood relief



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


3. Independence Day Celebration


4. Tree plantation (15-08-2019)


Tree plantation drive was conducted on 15-08-2019. 99 cadets participated in the programme.







6. Gandhi Jayanti (02-10-2019)






NCC Activity 2018-19

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



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
