




NATIONAL WEBINAR ON INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR)

(10th FEBRUARY 2021)

Department of Botany in association with IQAC and Research and Development Cell (SSC) organized a national Webinar on, "Introduction to IPR and Patents and their importance" technically supported by *Intellectual Property Rights Information Centre- Kerala (IPRICK)* and *Kerala State Council for Science, Technology and Environment.* The webinar programme was arranged in online platform Google meet on 10.02.2021 at 07.00 PM. The main objectives of the national webinar was to make better knowledge about the significance of the Intellectual Property Right among students, researchers and academicians. The focal theme for the seminar includes Patent for

inventions, Trademarks, Industrial designs and Geographical indications, Copyrights etc. The programme committee was coordinated by Dr. Shibu P. Varghese and Ms. Chinju Merin Abraham Pournami P., Dr.Sreejai R., Ms. Chinju (Assistant Professors). Dr. Praveen Dhar T (Assistant Professor of Botany and Convener of the programme) welcomed the chief guest and other dignitaries. Fr.(Dr.) **Roy John**, Head of the Department of Botany presided over the function and she delivered presidential address and he highlighted the need of organizing Intellectual Property Rights and related programme in colleges. The programme was formally inaugurated by Dr. K.P. Laladhas, Principal of the college. He explained the significance of conducting this types programme in graduate and post graduate level. He highlighted the significance of the areas related to Intellectual Property Rights such as Patent, Trademarks, Industrial designs and Geographical indications, Copyrights in research and scientific world. The second session was started at 07.20 PM aimed at cognitive enlargement session and theme presentation. In the second session, the introduction of the chief guest was done by Dr.Shibu P Varghese., Assistant professor in Botany. In this session the theme of the webinar was presented by Sri. Ajith M. (Deputy Controller of Patents and Designs, Patent Office, Chennai, Tamil Nadu). He delivered a speech on a topic 'Introduction to IPR and Patents and their importance'. The areas such as Copy right act 1957, Patents, Trademarks and trade name, Industrial designs or model, Geographical indications Copyrights, inventions and patenting, related rights, unfair competition, forgery and counter feting techniques, industrial property, plant variety, intellectual activity in the industrial, scientific, literary or artistic fields. etc., were explained in detailed manner. He also highlighted the sub areas such as human intellect including creativity concepts, inventions, industrial models, trademarks, songs, literature, symbols, names, brands. He also explained how to file patent in an effective manner.

The third session of the webinar was the open discussion and it was started at 8.15 PM in order to clarify the doubts and for extending the knowledge related to Intellectual Property and related areas. The concepts such as personal creativity out puts, patent filing procedures and measures, authentic publication, usage and priority, IPR and legal issues, biopiracy, biosafety like issues, plagiarism also discussed very effective manner. Students of various grades, research scholars of different department and teachers were actively participated in the discussion session. The students extended their vote thanks through feed back session arranged after the formal discussion session. A total 100 participants including students of various levels, research scholars of different departments, academicians and alumni members were actively participated in various sessions.
