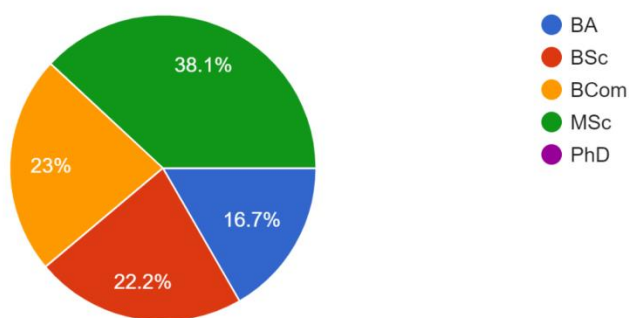
**Curriculum Feedback: 2021-22**

## ACTION TAKEN REPORT

1. Departments were also asked to conduct class tests on each unit of the subject .Library was instructed to include more books related to the syllabus. Suggestions given to internal exam committee to schedule exams in a timely manner .The institution decided to send more teachers for Refresher courses/ Seminars/ Workshops.
2. The collected feedback forms are analysed and discussed in the department meetings The Head of the Department personally interacts with the teachers to improve their skills in imparting knowledge, completion of syllabus etc. in case the students demands. In general the majority of all feed backs are Positive. By creation of interest to pursue higher education, IQAC suggests to conduct orientation programmes in department level at the beginning of semester in UG and PG programmes.
