

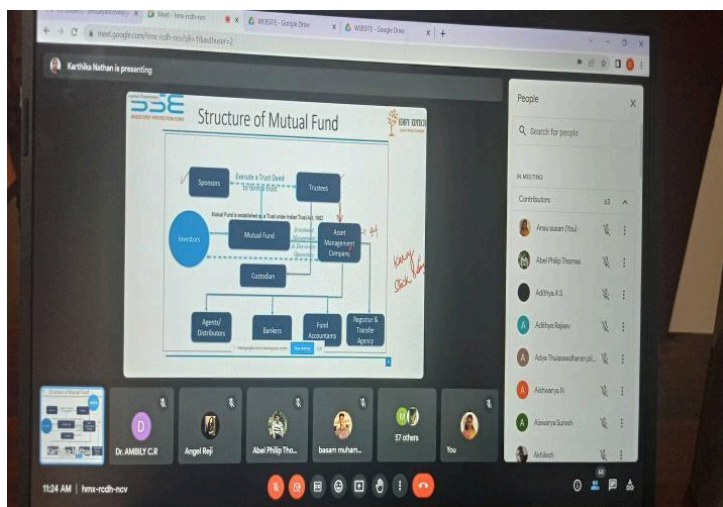
NATIONAL WEBINAR CONDUCTED IN ASSOCIATION WITH BOMBAY STOCK EXCHANGE

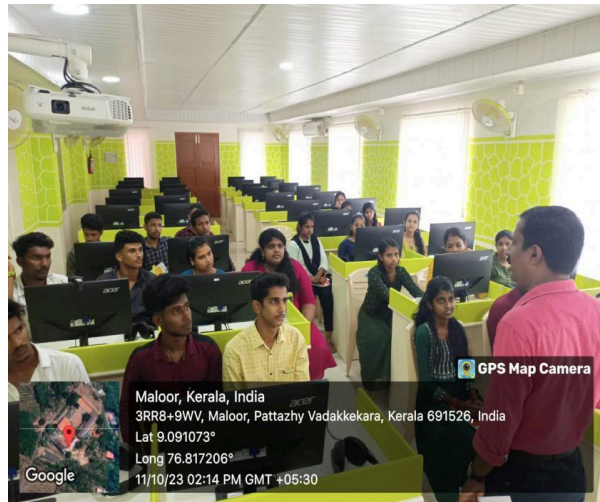


LIBRARY ORIENTATION PROGRAMME

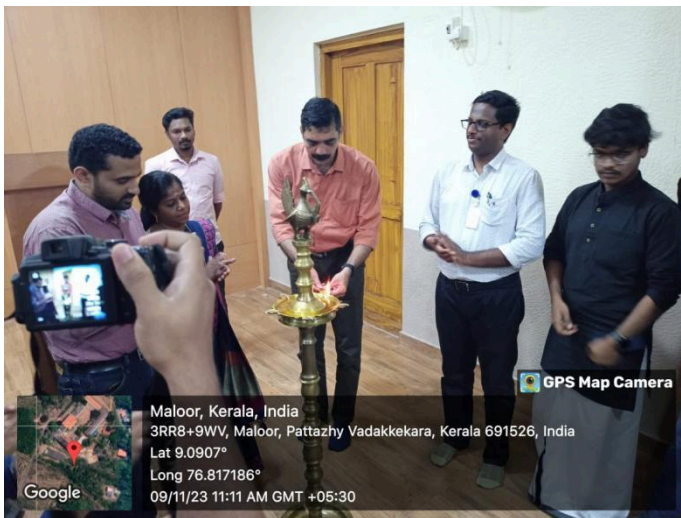


**INAUGURATION OF CERTIFICATE COURSE, NATIONAL

The Freshers Day Program for students started at 1:45 pm in the auditorium. The programme came to an end by 3:15 pm



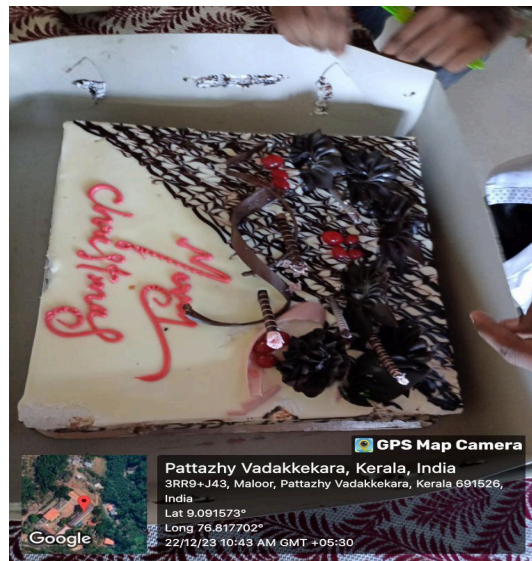


CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION

18.01.2024

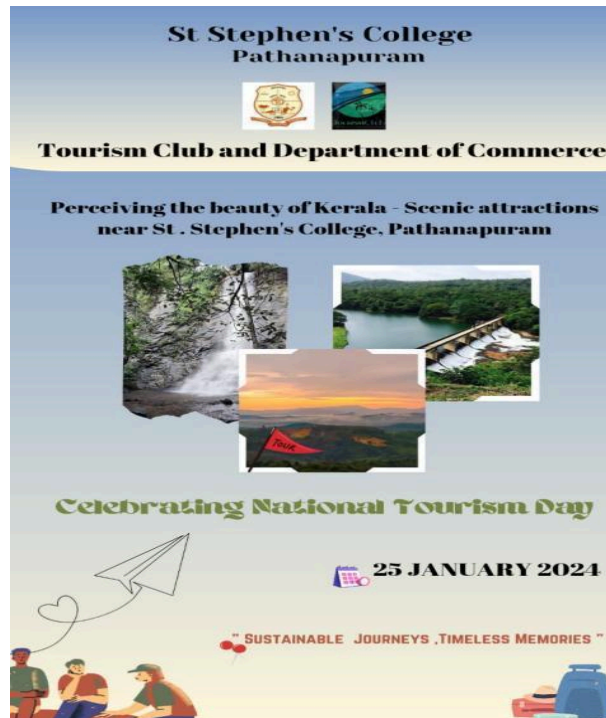

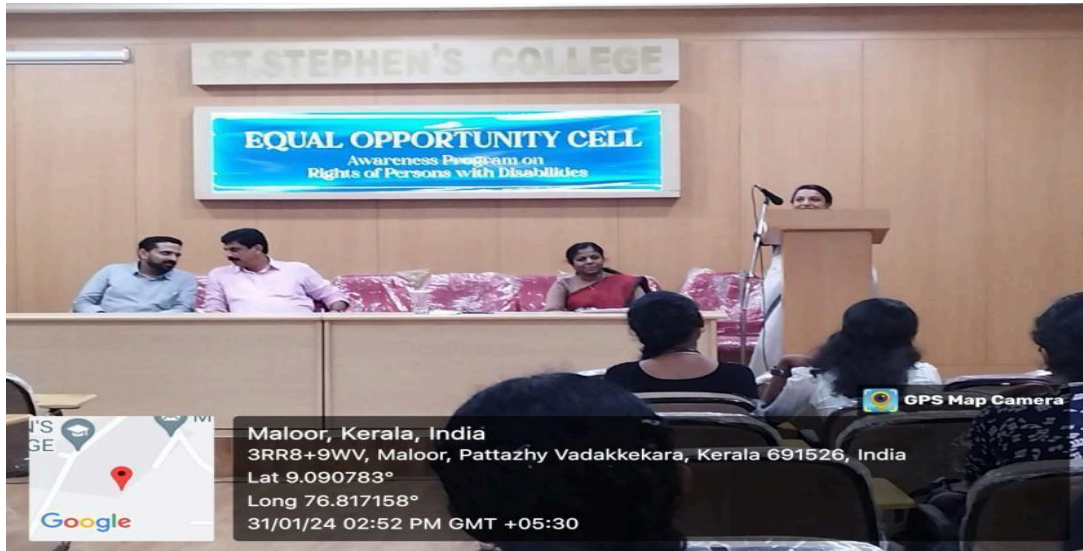

13/02/2024

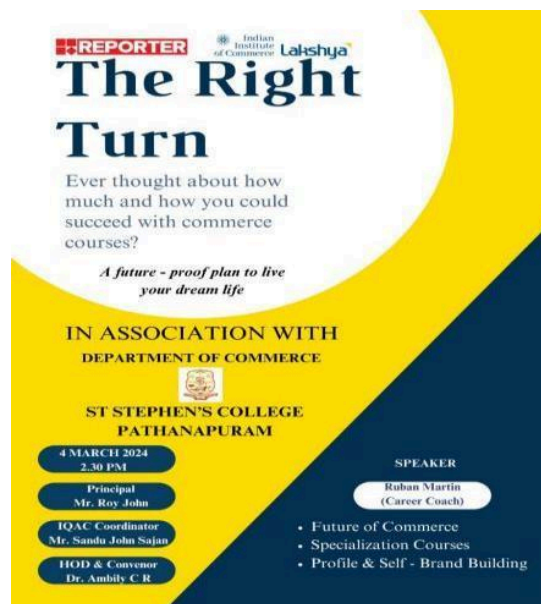
