

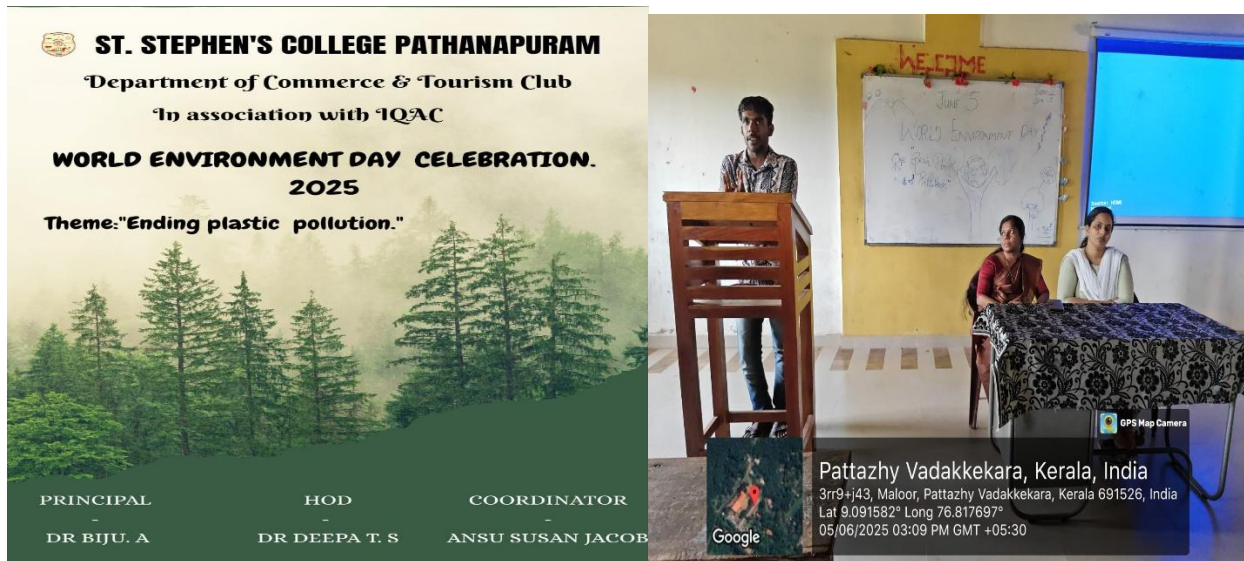

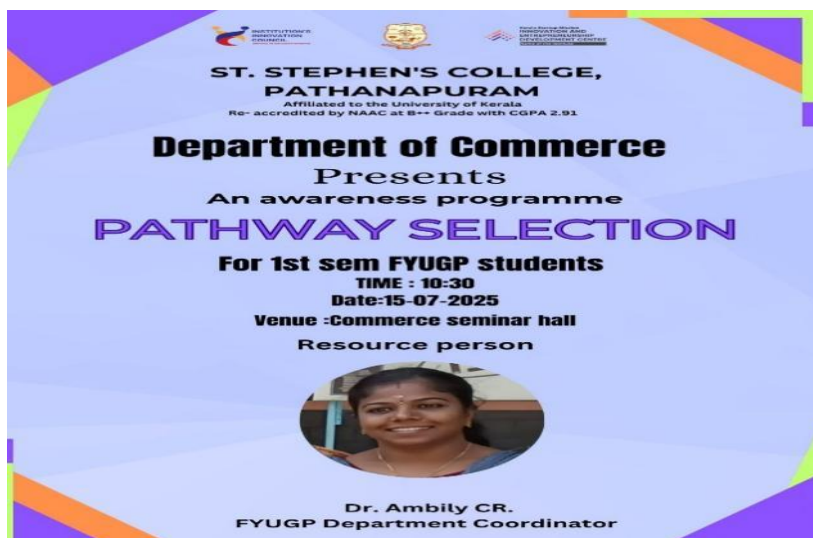
05.06.2025 World Environment Day Celebration 2025

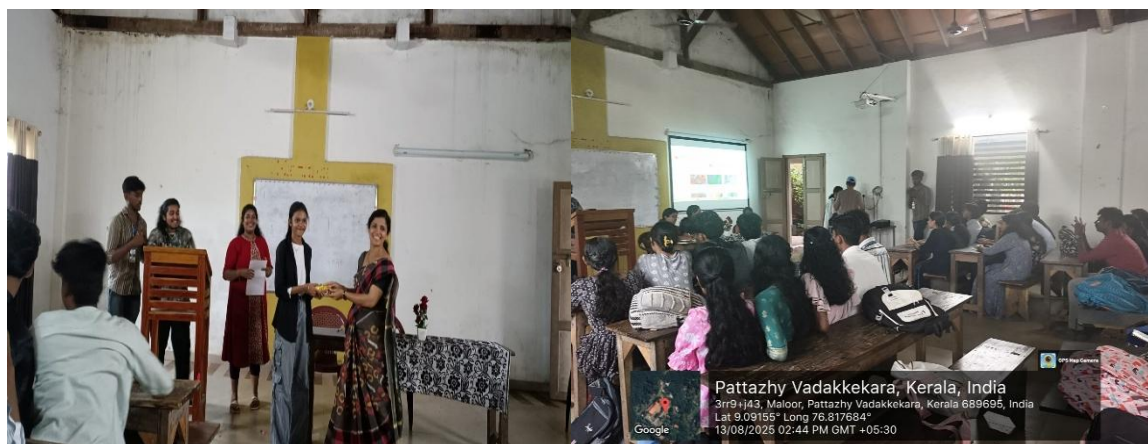
21.07.2025 Seminar on “Stand out from the crowd with ACCA”

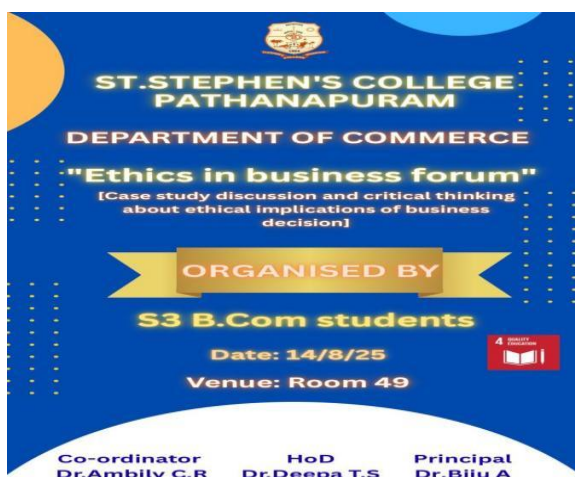
13.08.2025 Independence Day Celebrations

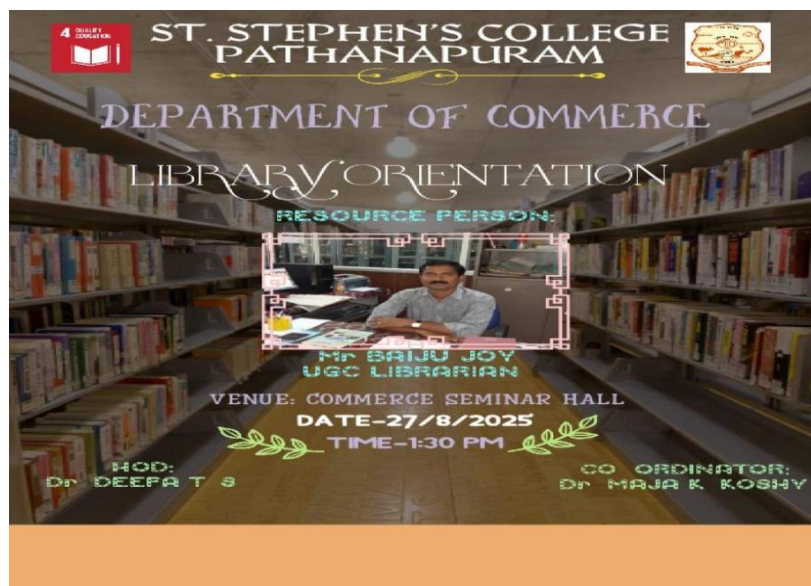

Library Orientation Programme

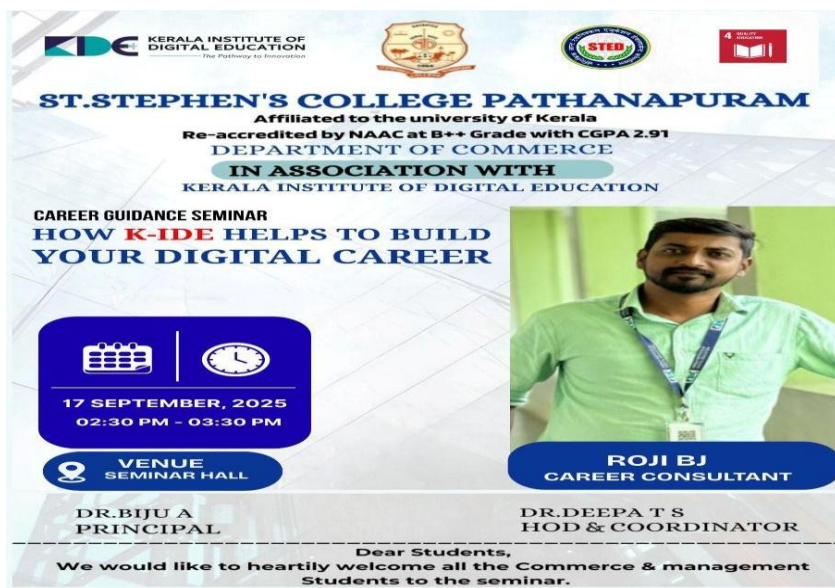

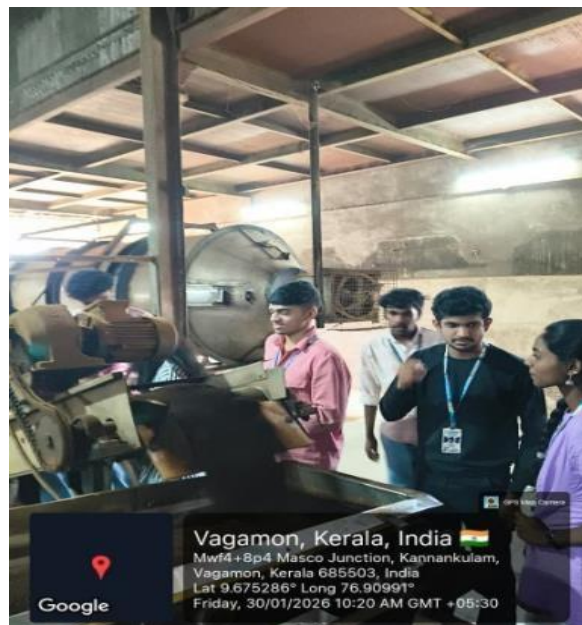


30.01.2026: INDUSTRIAL VISIT 2024 ADMISSION

30.01.2026: STUDY TOUR & INDUSTRIAL VISIT 2023 ADMISSION

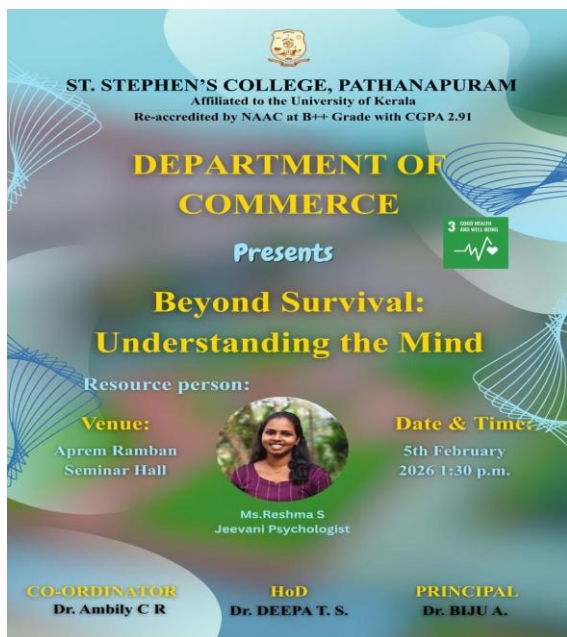

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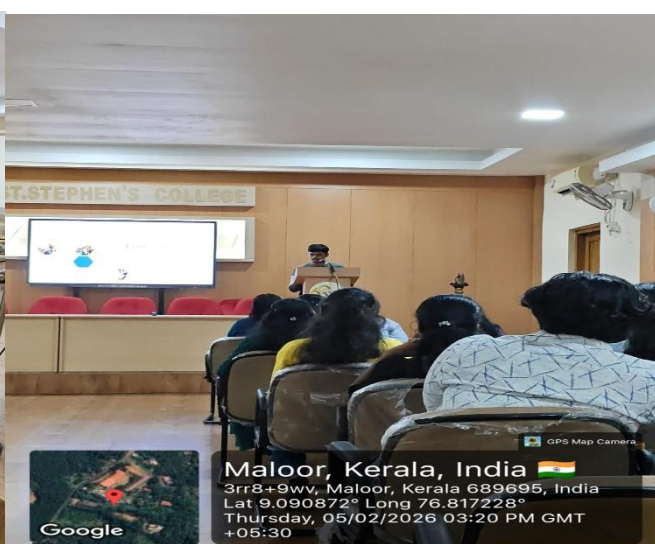

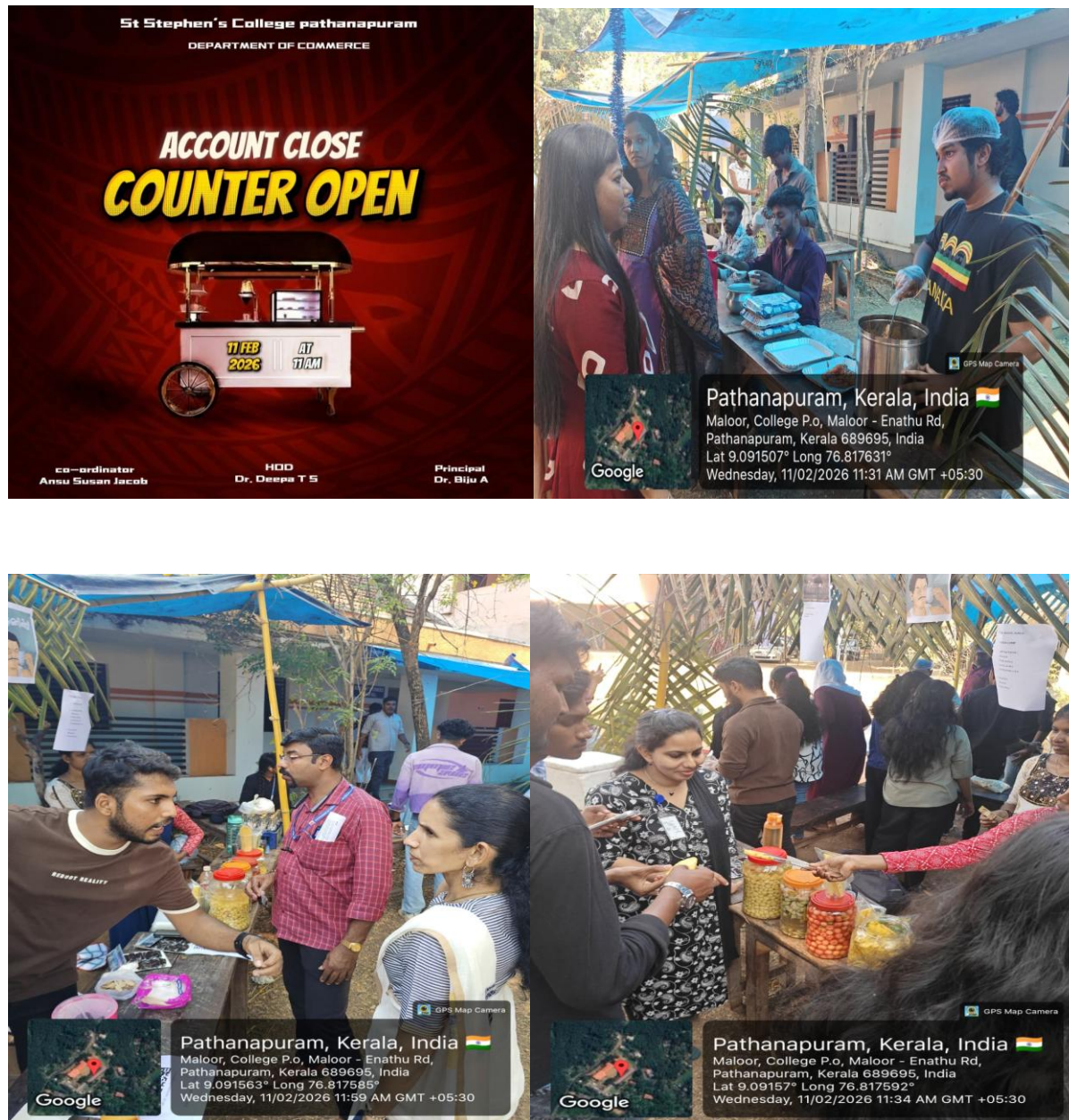

30.03.2026: CRAFT MAKING WORKSHOP

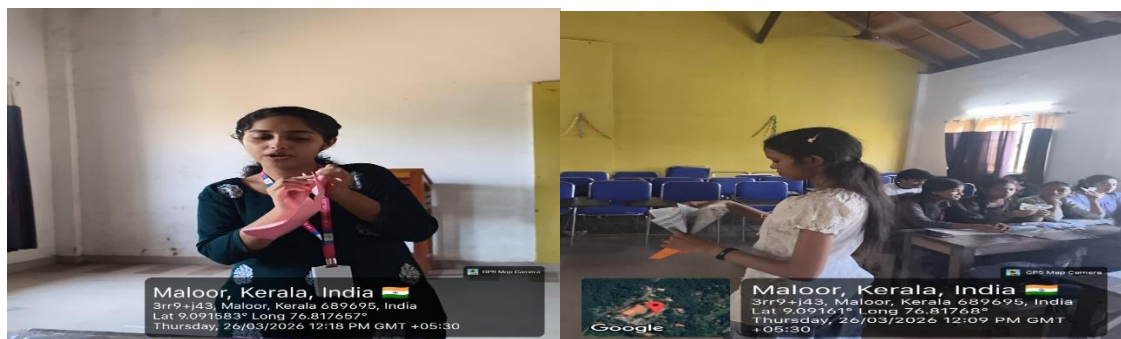
