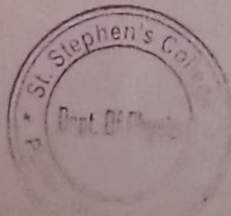

Executive Summary

The International Week of Science and Peace (IWOSP) is an annual observance from November 9-15, established by the United Nations to highlight the role of science in fostering peace and development, encouraging collaboration, addressing global challenges, and promoting scientific literacy for a better world. Originating from the 1986 International Year of Peace, it features events like conferences and workshops to connect scientists, policymakers, and the public on themes like sustainable development, health, and conflict resolution.

The year 2025 marks the first initiative of observing this week at our institution by the Department of Physics. Every year we will be conducting different programs based on the observance. This year we had two major events:

1. An Interdepartmental Quiz Competition on Science and Peace.
2. A one day seminar on Science Interlocution: Building Dialogues and Bridging Differences by Dr. Malavika Binny

The report is on the Interdepartmental Quiz conducted by Mr. Stephen Marydas (Assistant Professor of English) as the quiz master. We had 12 different teams (UG and PG from 8 departments). An initial screening was conducted using a written questionnaire and the final five teams were shortlisted from the same.

Objectives

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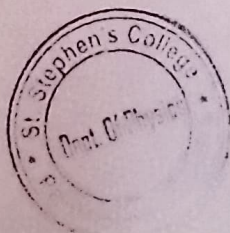

Executive Summary

The International Week of Science and Peace, celebrated annually from November 9th to 15th, was established by the United Nations in 1986 to promote the role of science in fostering peace and to encourage the use of scientific knowledge and technology for the benefit of humanity. This week highlights the importance of scientific research and collaboration in solving global challenges, including conflict resolution, poverty reduction, environmental protection, and sustainable development.

Our college starts celebrating International Week of Science and Peace from 2025. As part of the celebration we envisaged a talk on Science and Peace from a historical perspective. Dr. Malavika Binny, a distinguished historian, academic, and writer who currently serves as the Assistant Professor and Head of the Department of History at Kannur University delivered a talk **“Science as Interlocution : Building dialogues and Bridging differences”**. She started off her talk with several shocking examples of how famous scientific discoveries were associated with oppressions on women and the discriminations faced by the people belonging to the so-called inferior caste. Our College honoured Dr. Malavika Binny for her contributions to the society. She has been selected as the Inherit Fellow for 2026-2027 from India at the prestigious Kate Hamburger Centre for Advanced Study at Humboldt University, Berlin, Germany. Dr. Binny's work on critical caste studies focusing on caste artefacts or the correlation between what is understood as heritage materials and caste has gained her recognition.

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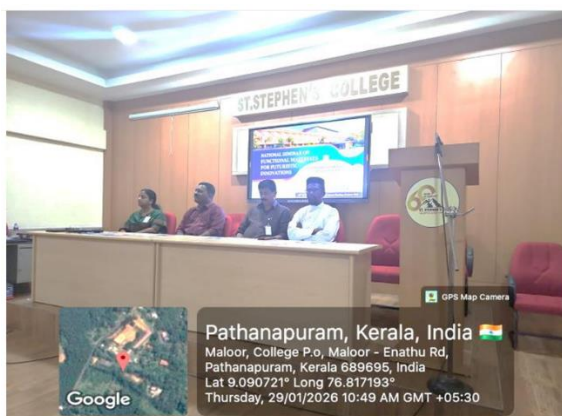

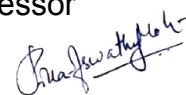

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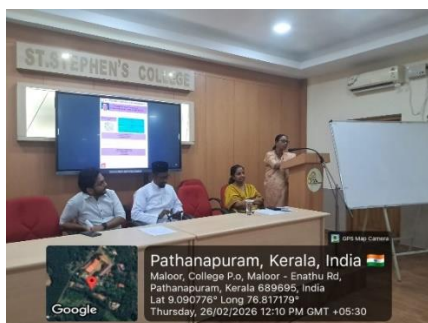

Furthermore, the competition is likely to promote intercollegiate collaboration and interaction, helping students build academic networks and share knowledge. Overall, the program is expected to cultivate a deeper interest in science and encourage students to actively engage in learning and intellectual activities.

Number and Type of Participants

The *Dr. Baby K. Paul Intercollegiate Quiz Competition* organized by the Department of Physics of St. Stephen's College, Pathanapuram witnessed active participation from students representing various nearby colleges. A total of approximately **5 teams** participated in the competition, with each team comprising **two members**.

The participants were primarily students from science streams, especially physics, though the quiz also encouraged participation from students of other disciplines with an interest in general science and current affairs. The diverse academic backgrounds of the participants contributed to a competitive and intellectually stimulating environment.

The event successfully brought together young minds from different institutions, promoting collaboration, knowledge sharing, and academic interaction among students.
